# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules Of Sailing.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Sail Canada to the Racing Rules Of Sailing apply for all races.
- 1.3 All races of the T.E.L.D.S. are a Category 4 Event under the ISAF Offshore Special Regulations.

# 2. ADVERTISING

2.1 There are no restrictions on advertising.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of all classes holding a valid PHRF certificate and insurance.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the appropriate registration forms and the club hosting the race.

#### 4. FEES

4.1 Fees for individual races will be set and collected by the club hosting the race upon registration.

#### 5. SCHEDULE

5.1 The schedule of races will be as follows:

19-JUN-2015 @ 1930 - Whitby 50 - Whitby Yacht Club

04-JUL-2015 @ 1100 - Singer Long Distance Race - Frenchman's Bay Yacht Club

08-AUG-2015 @ 1000 - Bluffer's Distance Race - Bluffer's Basin

11-SEP-2015 @ 1930 - Whitby 100 - Whitby Yacht Club

26-SEP-2015 @ 1000 - Donald Summerville Race - Ashbridge's Bay Yacht Club

#### 6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Each boat must hold a valid PHRF certificate.

#### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 Sailing instructions will be available from, and are the responsibility of the hosting club.

#### 8. SCORING

- 8.1 Scoring for the series will be by the Low Point System.
- 8.2 One rase is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3 Up to two races can be dropped from the series, if all 5 races are completed.

#### 9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Each boat may communicate with any person, competitor, sailboat or outside source of information available using any means available throughout the race.

#### 10. PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be the responsibility of the club hosting the race, and may be supplemented by the T.E.L.D.S. organizing committee.

#### 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

## 12. INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy with a minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 CAD per event for Canadian sailboats and an adequate level of third-party liability insurance applicable in Canadian and US waters for non-Canadian sailboats.
