

## **BLUFFERS CHALLENGE RACE CBYC, BPYC, HYC, SBSC**

**SATURDAY, AUGUST 8, 2015**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Welcome all to the inaugural “Bluffers Challenge Race,” the third race of the inaugural TELDS! The basin itself includes four separate clubs, and we will also be hosting our local “Basin Open” the same day. Hopefully, we’ll see a good number of boats because we’ll be running the two races simultaneously. Basin boats are eligible to be scored for both events; visiting yachts must choose between the two.

Local Basin racers doing our “Basin Open” will start at mark 0 just outside the harbour, round T2 (red buoy) off the Leslie Spit to port and finish between the committee boat and mark 0. TELDS racers will race the same course but continue through the finish at 0 (becoming a gate) to the Ajax weather buoy, round to port, and finish again between the committee boat and mark 0. Depending on conditions race day, the course may be shortened to Manse Rd buoy.

Though official registration will be Saturday morning of the race, skippers are asked to **pre-register** (see email on attached registration form) a week before to help determine both division splits and slip assignments for visiting yachts. For those arriving the night before, the CBYC restaurant will be open if you would like to purchase dinner. The restaurant will also be open for their regular breakfast from 7:30 AM before the skippers’ meeting.

Where possible, boats will be assigned slips at CBYC. Overflow docking will be available at one of the other clubs. A map of the basin is included in the Sailing Instructions.

Registration will be 08:00 to 09:00 at CBYC restaurant Saturday August 8. (But please don’t forget to pre-register.)

There is a compulsory skippers’ meeting on Saturday morning beginning at 09:30.

First warning signal will be Saturday morning at 11:00
