GENERAL CONDITIONS AND ADMINISTRATION

1. Entry and Registration

- **1.1.** The owner(s) of a boat intending to participate must complete a registration form and submit payment of the registration fee(s) with a signed liability waiver, before the boat is allowed to race and/or be scored.
- **1.2.** The Registration Deadline is 9:45, August 17th, 2019. No grace period will be granted.
- **1.3.** The Race Committee reserves the right to refuse and/or rescind entry of any boat at their sole discretion.

2. Classes and Eligibility

- **2.1.** Each participating keelboat race must have a valid PHRF-LO certificate. For the competitors in Fun Race a handicap will be assigned based on either a valid PHRF-LO certificate or a rating as assigned by the Race Committee with no appeal.
- **2.2.** The division splits, containing a minimum of a spinnaker, non-flying sails and fun race split will be presented at the Skipper's Meeting and will be at the sole discretion of the organizing body.
- **2.3.** Eligibility for the Fun Race will be subject to review by the Race Committee at registration. This determination will be made by the Race Committee at their sole reasonable discretion and not subject to protest.

3. Inspection and Measurement

3.1. Each participating boat is subject to check for rating compliance and if found in non-compliance may be disqualified from the race at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority.

4. Entry Fee, Waiver and Insurance

4.1. The entry fees:

Saturday August 17th, 2019

- **4.1.1.** Basin Open \$30 after August 14th up to the deadline and \$20 up to August 14th.
- **4.1.2.** Fun Race No Cost upon completion of a registration form.
- **4.1.3.** All fees are payable by cash or cheque to the "Highland Yacht Club".

5. Registration, Check-in and Mooring

- **5.1.** Registration forms are available at: https://www.bpyc.on.ca/documents/2019/2019%20Basin%20Racing%20Entry%20Form.pdf
- **5.2.** Onsite Registration and Check-in will be at the Scarborough Bluffs Sailing Club on the top floor on August 17th from approximately 08:30 to 09:45. https://www.sailingclub.on.ca/content.aspx?page_id=22&club_id=934493&module_id=138060
- **5.3.** All Non-Basin resident boats shall make arrangement to secure space for mooring as SBSC has limited ability to accommodate visiting keel boats. Visitors to SBSC shall not interfere with launch, sailing school or general operations. Mooring is not permitted on areas of SBSC docks with yellow strips.

6. Skippers' Meeting

- **6.1.** A mandatory Skippers' Meeting will be on August 17th at approximately 09:45 at SBSC, all Skippers or their designate must attend in person or risk automatic disqualification.
- **6.2.** Amendments to the Notice of Racer and division splits will be finalized and communicated at this meeting.

7. Schedule of Race

- **7.1.** Will take place on August 17th.
- **7.2.** The first Warning Signal will be approximately 10:55, but may be delayed if the race organization committee requires extra time.
- 7.3. The last Warning Signal will not be after 15:00.

8. Rules and Regulations

8.1. All races will be governed by the current Bluffers Basin Challenge Series Racing Handbook and Sailing Instructions 25-Jun-2019 Edition available at: https://www.bpyc.on.ca/documents/2019/2019 Basin Race Handbook%20-%202019-06-25.pdf

9. Amendments

- **9.1.** References to Spring, Summer or Fall maybe ignored or interpreted as this series.
- 9.2. Backup committee boat section deleted.

9.3. Curfew will be 17:00.

10. Provisional Classes and Divisional Starts

- **10.1.** The fleets for the Basin Open races will be provisionally divided into three starts one for Non-Flying Sails, one for Flying Sails, and one for Fun racers, and the classes which will start first and second respectively.
- **10.2.** The classes scoring purposes will be based on total number of entries in each division and may be merged if only one boat starts in the class at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- **10.3.** The provisional class starts will be as per the table below:

Start	Class	Description
1	One	Non-Flying Sails – PHRF ASP 195 and above
1	Two	Non-Flying Sails – PHRF ASP 194 and below
2	Three	Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 99 and below
2	Four	Flying Sails – PHRF ASP 100 and above
3	Fun Division	Non-Flying Sails - PHRF ASP – All

11. Scoring and Scoring System

- **11.1.** Scoring will be as per "Bluffers Basin Challenge Series Racing Handbook and Sailing Instructions" booklet, 2019 Edition.
- **11.2.** All races will be scored, a minimum of two (2) races shall constitute a series.
- **11.3.** Scoring System will be PHRF-LO Time on Time (TOT) with adjustment of elapsed time that will use the following values:

TOT multiplier = $566.431 \div (401.431 + PHRF TOD ASP)$

12. Results and Awards

- **12.1.** Race results will be available after the Open Basin completed.
- **12.2.** Basin club participants *may* be scored for a Basin only awards at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- **12.3.** Flags for the overall division winners in First (1st), Second (2nd) and Third (3rd) place will be awarded for the Basin Open.
- **12.4.** Flags will be awarded by organizing authority no later than at the annual race awards banquet and will be available after this event for those who cannot attend.
