MODIFICATIONS TO HANDBOOK AND RULES

COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

Each skipper is responsible for ensuring their compliance with government mandates and laws with regard to Covid-19 safety

CALENDAR

Up to two races per day will be held Sunday, September 12, 19 & 26, 2021.

RACE START TIME AND CURFEWS

The committee boat will leave the dock at approximately **10:15** hours each day. The "R" flag will be taken down at approximately **10:54** hours. The first start will be at approximately **11:00** hours. Each race will have a two-hour curfew, and the day's curfew is **15:30** hours, boats finishing after a curfew will be scored DNF, this modifies the curfews noted on Page 15.

In the event that racing is postponed by the Race Committee as indicated by an AP code flag and this will likely result in only one race being run, the single race curfew will be replaced by the day's curfew of **15:30** hours.

STARTING AREA

Boats <u>will</u> be permitted to sail through the Start Line on their second leg, this modifies the Start Area as indicated on Page 11.

COURSES

The Spinnaker & White Sails divisions will race the same four (4) legs course, with **no** ("S" or "W") letter before the course. The Fun Division will have a course that will be indicated by an "M" prior to the legs.

SCORING CLASSES AND DIVISIONAL STARTS

The fleet will be divided into three classes for the purpose of scoring and into two divisional starts as per the table below:

Start	Division	Description
1	1	Non-Flying Sails - PHRF ASP over 190
2	2	Non-Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 190 and under
3	3	Flying Sails - PHRF ASP all
4	4	Fun Division

POINTS AND SCORING SYSTEM

Points will be awarded as per the current edition of "Bluffers Basin Challenge Series Racing Handbook and Sailing Instructions". In series scoring the table on Page 16 will be modified to reflect a maximum of six (6) races, thus if 5 to 6 are raced, only 4 of the races will be counted.
