CALENDAR

Up to two races per day will be held Sunday, September 11, 18, & 25, 2016.

RACE START TIME

The committee boat will leave the dock at approximately **10:15** hours each day.

The "R" flag will be taken down at approximately **10:54** hours.

The first start will be at approximately **11:00** hours.

Curfew is **16:00** hours, and any boat finishing thereafter will be scored DNF.

SCORING CLASSES AND DIVISIONAL STARTS

The fleet will be divided into four classes for the purpose of scoring and into two divisional starts as per the table below:

| Start | Division | Description |
|-------|----------|---|
| 1 | 1 | Non-Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 199 and over |
| 1 | 2 | Non-Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 198 and under |
| 2 | 3 | Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 100 and over |
| 2 | 4 | Flying Sails - PHRF ASP 99 and under |

NOTE: For the all divisions, the RC will post the course for each start. Racers are reminded to watch for RC signals regarding shortened course.

POINTS AND SCORING SYSTEM

Points will be awarded as per "Bluffers Basin Challenge Series Racing Handbook and Sailing Instructions" booklet, 2016 Edition. In series scoring the table on Page 16 will be modified to reflect a maximum of six (6) races and if 5

or more races are raced, the best 4 will be counted. If 4 and fewer races are raced, then all races will be scored.
